KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That J. P. STEVENS & CO., INC. a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 (\$1.00) Dollar in hand paid by GREENVILLE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville County, South Carolina, a right of way (fifty feet in width) for the relocation of a portion of Bates Bridge Road at Slater in Greenville County, South Carolina, including the right of locating, constructing, improving and maintaining said roadway.

The aforesaid right of way begins at a point at a curve in the Bates Bridge Road (south of a railroad spur and near the Waste House of the grantor herein) and runs in a northwesterly direction from said point a distance of seven hundred feet, more or less, to the Slater-Marietta Road.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

In accepting this easement the grantee herein hereby releases any and all interest it may have in that portion of the Bates Bridge Road as presently located which lies between the curve hereinabove referred to and Slater-Marietta Road and hereby consents to the closing of the same.
