all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, Bates Township, on the S/S of State Road 186, adjoining said road, Bates Road and land of grantee which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office in Greenville County in Book 446, page 102, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Bates Road on the right-of-way of State Road 186 and running with said right-of-way 197 feet to the Bates line; thence with said Bates line 200 feet East to a point in the center of Bates Road; Newton corner; thence 40 feet to the beginning corner.
