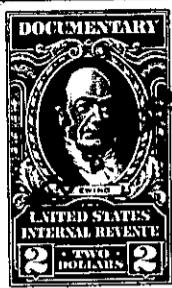

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Richard B. Pressley

and no/100 (\$10,900) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Harry J. House and Helen C. House

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Harry J. House and  
Helen C. House, their heirs and assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina being known and designated as lot No. 7 of  
Block F, according to the plat by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engr., recorded in  
Plat Book F, page 160, in the R. M. C. Office for said Greenville  
County. Said lot has a frontage of eighty (80) feet on the South  
side of Patton Street, and a depth of One Hundred (100) feet according  
to said plat. Said lot has the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING on the South side of Patton Street at the corner  
of lot No. 5, Block F, thence running with Patton Street, N. 65-15 E.  
80 feet to corner of lot No. 9 on Patton Street; thence with line of  
lot No. 9, Southeasterly 100 feet to common corner of lots Nos. 8, 9,  
and 10, Block F; thence with line of lot No. 8, S: 65-15 W. 80 feet to  
common corner of lots Nos. 5, 6, and 8 of Block F; thence with line of  
lot No. 5, Northwesterly 100 feet to the beginning corner.
