All those pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in a section known as Nickletown, being known and designated as Lot Nos. 31 and 32 of a subdivision of the property of W. N. Miller and E. E. Stone as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Will D. Neves, Engineer, March 12, 1914 and recorded in the R. M. C. By his last will and testament on file in the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County in Apartment 529, File 8, the said Joe Redmon (Joseph Clarence Redmon) devised a life estate to me, with the remainder to Lula Mae Shumate. The remainder interest of the said Lula Mae Shumate was conveyed to me by deed dated May 21, 1948 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 349 at Page 419.
