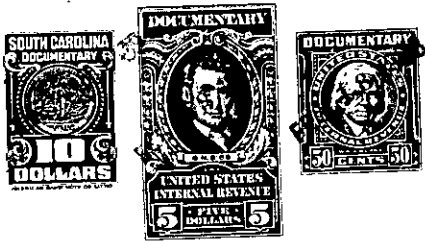
Know All Men by These Presents:

Huffman in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Forty-Seven Hundred Eighty-Nine (\$4,789.00) - - - - - DOLLARS, and assumption of mortgage to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James O. Bishop and Frankie E. Bishop, their heirs and assigns,

ALL that certain lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, known and designated as Lot 52 and the adjoining (or northern) one-half of Lot 51 on a plat of Glendale Heights, prepared by J. Mac Richardson in February, 1958, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book KK, at page 143, and having, according to this plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Knox Street, joint front corner of Lots 52 and 53, and running thence with the line of Lot 53, N 83-15 E 150 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 44; thence with the rear line of Lots 44 and 45, S 6-45 E 105 feet to a point in the rear line of Lot 51; thence through the center of Lot 51, S 83-15 W 130 feet to a point in the front line of Lot 51 and on the eastern side of Knox Street; thence with the eastern side of Knox Street N 6-45 W 105 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to us by deed of James E. Burger recorded in Vol. 607, page 403.
