All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of a subdivision known as Oakland Terrace as shown on a plat thereof being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB at Page 196, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Zelma Drive, joint front corner Lots Nos. 3 and 4 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 43-16 E. 225.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 41-55 W. 90 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 48-15 W. 230.8 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Zelma Drive; thence with said Drive, N. 43-41 E. 50.1 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Zelma Drive, N. 46-44 E. 49.9 feet to the beginning corner.
