FIFTH: The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows:

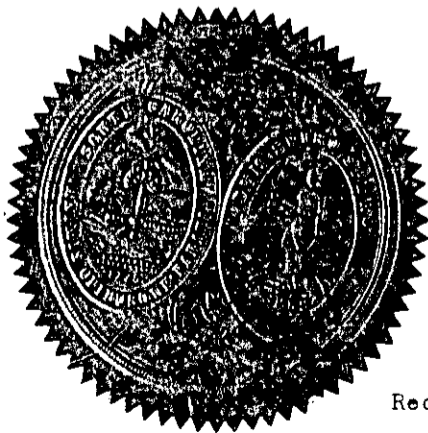
