to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. Herman Phillips, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southwest side of the Laurens Road near the City of Greenville, in Butler Township, in Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to a plat made by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, May 26, 1946, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of Laurens Road at the northeast corner of the Wood property; thence along the Laurens Road, N. 46-23 W. 100 feet to a point; thence down the center of the original property 641.5 feet to a point on the Old Laurens Road; thence along the old Laurens Road, S. 51-59 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence to an iron pin at corner of Wood property; thence with said Wood property, N. 39-32 E. 637 feet to the point of beginning.

This being a portion of the property conveyed to grantor and grantee jointly by deed of Gabrielle Austin and Charley V. Austin, dated July 27, 1948, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 354 at page 271.
