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twenty-five (25) feet from the center of said pipe line or lines, in, upon, and through the property of Henry Cruell Estate as shown on a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, November 25, 1958, which plat is attached to and made a part of the Notice of Condemnation.

The location of the center of the said pipe line or lines as the said pipe line or lines pass through the property of Henry Cruell Estate according to said plat will be as follows:

Entering the North boundary line of the property of Henry Cruell Estate at a point in the South side of the right of way of the Bates Crossing Road, which point is 21 feet, more or less, in a Southeastern direction from the North corner of the Henry Cruell Estate tract, at Station 537+ 59.3 of the survey of the North Saluda Reservoir pipe line and runs thence through the property of Henry Cruell Estate, S. 21-06 E., 536.2 feet to Station 542+ 95.5 (bk) and Station 542+ 25.3 (fwd); thence still through the property of Henry Cruell Estate, S. 0-02 W., 704.5 feet to Station 549+ 29.8 of the survey, which point is in the Southern boundary line of the Henry Cruell Estate tract at a point 445.0 feet, more or less, in a Southeastern direction from an oak corner of the said Henry Cruell Estate tract.

The property affected by this right of way is the same conveyed to Henry Cruell by deed of George Brownlee dated November 21, 1916, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 36, page 140; the said Henry Cruell having subsequently died intestate leaving as his sole heirs at law the landowners named in the Notice of Condemnation,

and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, a pipe line or lines, air vents, blow off connections, manholes and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line or lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line or lines all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger or interfere with the proper operation of or access to the same.

It is understood and agreed that the right of way to be used under this contract during construction is to be seventy-five feet in width throughout the entire length which is approximately 1241 feet, and the damage, which The City of Greenville, South Carolina, is to be liable for during construction, is to be confined to this strip and nothing beyond. The location of the pipe line or lines, when laid, will determine the definite location of the right of way. The center of the pipe line or lines shall be accepted as lying twenty-five feet from the West boundary line of this right of way. The remaining fifty feet of said right of way during construction shall lie East of the center of said pipe line or lines and the entire right of way may be used for the purpose of installing the pipe line or lines. The location of said pipe line or lines is to be approximately along the line as now located and staked out by the engineers, subject to a variation of not exceeding five feet either way. The permanent right of way, after the pipe line or lines are

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
