ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, GREENLIT BUILDERS, INC., by its duly authorized officers, does hereby assign, transfer and set over all of its right, title and interest in and to that certain lease made and entered into the 25th day of April, 1959, by and between Greenlit Builders, Inc. and The United States of America, whereby the following described premises were conveyed by lease to the Government. The leased premises are as follows:

All that certain room, 38' x 68', providing 2,584 square feet of floor space, net, inside measurements, on the first floor, and canopy-covered mail platform, 35' x 20', providing 700 square feet of space; paved area approximately 20' x 80', in front; 15' wide paved driveway on each side of the building from U. S. Highway 276; 4,800 square feet, more or less, of paved area at rear; and about 2,700 square feet of grassed and planting area, around the one-story, masonry building, situated on the east side of U. S. Highway 276; between Muckelhenny Road and Junction of U. S. Hwy. 276 and U. S. Hwy. 25, in Travelers Rest, Greenville County, South Carolina.

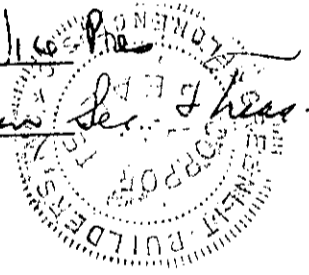
