sum of **Six Thousand and No/100ths (\$6,000.00)** dollars, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto **FIDELITY COMPANY, INC.:**

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southerly side of Thruston Street and on the Northerly side of Wakefield Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having according to a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated June 29, 1959, entitled "Survey for Furman University", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book **TT** at page **1**, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southerly side of Thruston Street, which iron pin is located 207.6 feet in a Easterly direction from the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Thruston Street and Howe (formerly Nona Street), and running thence S. 13-32 E. 238.9 feet to an iron pin on the Northerly side of Wakefield Street; thence with the Northerly side of Wakefield Street N. 67-13 E. 84.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 8-38 W. 244 feet to an iron pin on the Southerly side of Thruston Street; thence with the Southerly side of Thruston Street S. 66-45 W. 105.8 feet to the point of beginning.



Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, **its** successors, ~~he~~ and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and **its** successors, ~~he~~ and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
