

A G R E E M E N T :

Travelers Rest, S. C.
July 29, 1959.

It is hereby agreed to, by J. V. Bishop and Paul M. Vernon, that an area ten (10) feet wide in the rear of the property now owned by the above parties, located on Hgw. 276, in the town of Travelers Rest, be kept open at all times for the use of as an alley way or drive way.

Said alley way or drive way is to run from the "School House Road" or McElhaney Road, in a straight line along the rear of property of J. A. League, estate, W. H. Vest estate, Dick Gaffney, Paul M. Vernon and J. V. Bishop.

The present deeds to part of the above property call for the rear line to extend 115 feet from the right of way along Hgw. 276. The agreement is that a ten (10) foot area be set aside on the rear line of each property holder for the sole purpose and use of as an alley way or drive way. The area set aside would begin at the rear joint corner of property of Dick Gaffney and Paul M. Vernon and run S. 47-01 E. 60 feet along rear of Paul M. Vernon and J. V. Bishop; thence 42-59 E. along line of Helen F. Griffin, ten (10) feet; thence N. 47-01 W. 60 feet; thence S. 42-59 W. 10 feet to the beginning corner.
