Alfred Parks Hammond died intestate on August 28, 1957, his wife having predeceased him, leaving as his sole heirs at law his brothers and sisters surviving at that time, together with nieces and nephews, children of Thomas A. Hammond, and Ethel Hill Hammett, niece, ~~and a nephew, son~~ of Leila H. Hill. Ethel P. Hammond died intestate on February 19, 1958, having never married, leaving as her sole heirs at law her brothers and sisters then surviving, together with nieces and nephews, the children of the Late Thomas A. Hammond and Ethel Hill Hammett, the only child of the late Leila H. Hill. All of those parties having an interest in the above described tract of land are of legal age and otherwise sui juris.
