release unto J. W. OVERTON, JR.:

All that parcel or lot of land lying and being in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina, being designated as Lot No. 69 as shown on Plat No.
Three, Cherokee Forest, prepared by J. Mac Richardson, R. L. S., in January,
1959, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South
Carolina, in Plat Book QQ at pages 36 and 37, and having, according to said
plat (as amended), the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern intersection of Roberta Drive
and Red Cherry Lane, and running thence along said intersection N. 34-29 W.
21.2 feet to an iron pin; thence along the Western side of Red Cherry Lane
S. 10-31 W. 301.8 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running N. 73-45 W.
