ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate  
on the East side of Laurens Road, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville  
County, South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the East side of Laurens Road, corner of property  
of Watkins, and runs thence with the line of said property, N. 35-08 E.  
314.5 feet to a stake at corner of Lot 12; thence with the line of said  
lot S. 56-04 E. 103.1 feet to a stake; thence S. 36-08 W. 341.8 feet to
