BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Merrywood Drive at the joint front corner Lots Nos. 107 and 108, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 25-24 W. 165.2 feet to an iron pin, the joint corner of Lots Nos. 107, 108 and 110; running thence along the line of Lot No. 110, N. 75-14 E. 72 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner Lots Nos. 108 and 109; running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 34-02 E. 150.4 feet to an iron pin on the northwestern side of said Merrywood Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 108 and 109; running thence along the northwestern side of said drive, N. 62-53 E. 93 feet to the point of beginning.

The purpose of this deed is to convey to the grantees a fee simple title to the above described property which belongs to the grantor. The deed from W. E. Shaw to Leo H. Shaw dated October 5, 1959 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 635, at Page 534 did not convey the title to the above described property.
