

Goldsmith; thence along the line of Goldsmith, S. 56-30 W. 880 feet to a stake at branch; thence down the meanders of said branch the following courses and distances: S. 15-15 E. 278 feet; S. 19-30 W. 520 feet; S. 6-15 W. 240 feet; S. 8-30 W. 870 feet to a stake at the intersection of two branches at the corner of property now or formerly of J. C.
