Know All Men by These Presents:

That D. E. NELSON in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars & Thirty Eight Cents (\$1,457.38) to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said WILLIAM IRA SAMPSON, His Heirs and Assigns; the grantor reserves to himself the option to repurchase this property within eighteen months from the date of this instrument, according to the terms of the written Agreement entered into this date with the Grantee.

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the South side of Dunbar Street, beginning at corner of lot now or formerly of Marcellus Tribble and running thence in a westerly direction along Dunbar Street 65 feet to corner of lot now or formerly of R. D. Smith; thence along line of said lot in a southerly direction 100 feet; thence in an easterly direction 65 feet to point in line of lot now or formerly of Julius Gardiner; thence in a northerly direction along line of said lot and lot of Tribble 100 feet to the beginning corner.

BEING the same lot conveyed to Andrew P. Holmes by D. E. Nelson on July 10, 1958 as noted in Deed Volume 600, page 5.
