



All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the northern side of Broadleaf Court being known and designated as Lot No. 24 of a subdivision known as Broadleaf Forest as shown on a plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book MM at Page 64 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
