All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate and being
in the State and County aforesaid. Being bounded on the East by
Haskell George, on the South by a fourteen foot driveway, seven feet
of which remains the property of H. H. Garrison; On the North and West
by lands of H. H. and Pansy P. Garrison.

Having the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron
pin at public road, joint corner of Hendrix property and running thence
along line of Hendrix property S. 82-15 W. 124 feet to a stake; thence
in a northerly direction 150 feet to a stump; thence in an Easterly
direction 125 feet to an iron pin; thence Southerly 223 feet to the
beginning corner.
