NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as Executor and Trustee under the Will of Stella H. Ellis, deceased, in order to carry out the terms of Item II(2)(3) of said will, and by virtue of the authority vested in it under said item of said will, has granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Margaret Ellis Anderson a one-half interest in and to the following-described property, to-wit:

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, at the Southwest corner of West North and North Main Streets, and having according to plat made by C. M. Furman, Jr. the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
