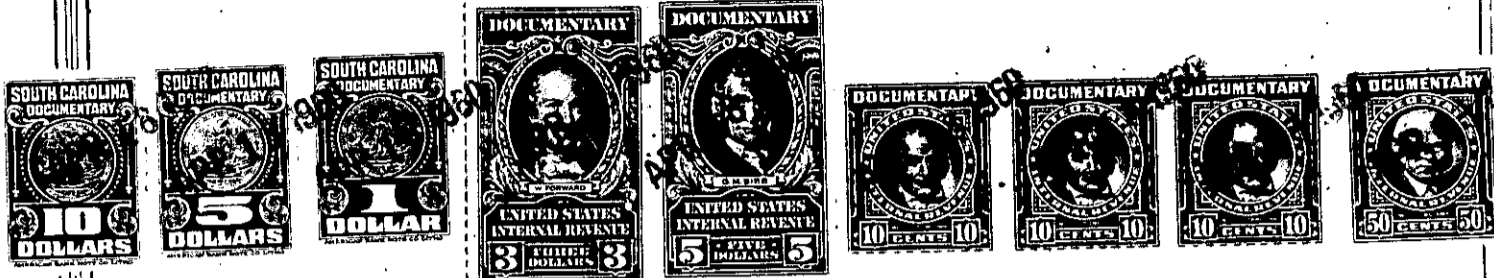

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.L.Craft and Floride J.
Craft, their heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina on the corner of School Street and Westfield
Street in the Town of Greer, and having the following courses and
distances, To-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the southwest corner of Westfield
and School Streets, and renning thence in a northerly direction
along School Street 156 feet to an iron pin; thence in a westerly
direction 76 feet to an iron pin; thence in a southern direction 156
feet to Westfield Street; thence along Westfield Street 76 feet to
the beginning corner. Westfield Street as referred to in this deed
was formerly named "Maude Street".
