WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) to it in hand paid by the said party of the second part, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of Couth Carolina, lying and being on the north west side of Johnson Street, being known and designated as Lot No. 128 on plat of East Lynne Addition made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May, 1933, recorded in the R. M. C. office in Plat Book H, at Page 220, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:
