LEASE

This LEASE made and entered into this 27th day of fune, 1960, by and between THOMAS M. WELBORN, of Greenville County, South Carolina, hereinafter called "Landlord", and AMERICAN MONORAIL CO., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Ohio, hereinafter called "Tenant";

WITNESSETH:

- (1) Demise. The Landlord does hereby lease and demise unto the Tenant, and the Tenant does hereby take as Tenant, upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, all that certain building measuring thirty (30) feet by one hundred twenty (120) feet to be erected as hereinafter set forth and to be situated adjacent to a building already located upon a tract of land owned by the Landlord in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, between the Grove Road and Church Street Extension (United States Highway No. 29).
