KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that ABNEY MILLS, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, by donation to GREENVILLE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of South Carolina, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said Greenville County, has granted and conveyed and does hereby grant and convey unto,

GREENVILLE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA:

All those pieces, parcels and strips of land situate, lying and being in the Poinsett Village near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and shown as the following streets and roadways on a plat entitled "Subdivision for Abney Mills, Poinsett Plant, Greenville, S. C." made by Dalton & Neves March 5, 1959 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ at page 51:

- (1) That portion of Owens Street lying outside the limits of the City of Greenville as shown on said plat;
- (2) Jefferson Circle as shown on said plat, exclusive of the area indicated thereon as "Park";
- (3) Brannon Street as shown on said plat;
- (4) That portion of Willard Street lying outside the limits of the City of Greenville as shown on said plat;
- (5) That portion of Cain Street lying outside the limits of the City of Greenville as shown on said plat;
- (6) That portion of Birnie Street Extension lying outside the limits of the City of Greenville as shown on said plat;
- (7) That portion of Vance Street lying within the boundary of the property of the grantor as shown on said plat.
