THIS INDENTURE made the <u>3rd</u> day of August, 1960, between JESSE M. RAY, as Special Master, party of the first part, and FEDERAL NATIONAL MORTGAGE ASSOCIATION, a corporation organized and existing pursuant to Title III of the Federal Housing Act, As Amended, party of the second part, whose permanent address is: City of Washington, District of Columbia:
