

CRAWFORD, JR. and LOUISE W. CRAWFORD, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Botany Road and Hearthstone Lane, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot #72, Sector II, Botany Woods Subdivision, plat made by Piedmont Engineering Service, July 1959, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book QQ, Page 79, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Botany Road at joint front corner of Lots 71 and 72 and runs thence along the line of Lot 71, S. 80-40 W., 185 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 14-02 E., 164.2 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Hearthstone Lane; thence with Hearthstone Lane, N. 77-50 E., 151.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Hearthstone Lane and Botany Road (the chord being N. 33-23 E., 35.6 feet) to an iron pin on the West side of Botany Road; thence with Botany Road, N. 11-05 W., 130 feet to the beginning corner.
