Know all Men by these presents, That I, Virginia Allen Potter,

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released,

and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Edmund L. Potter and
Virginia P. Crigler, their heirs and assigns forever:

An undivided one-eighth (1/8th) interest in and to:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being at the northerly corner of the intersection of Pettigru Street and Broadus Avenue, in the City of Greenville, S. C., and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northerly corner of the intersection of Pettigru Street and Broadus Avenue and running thence along the northeasterly side of Broadus Avenue N 15-00 W 257 feet, more or less, to an iron pin, corner of the property now or formerly belonging to Geer Estate; thence along the line of the Geer property N 73-29 E 213 feet, more or less, to an iron pin corner of property now or formerly belonging to W. G. Serrine; thence with the line of the Serrine property S 16-13 E 100 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing S 17-00 E 131.5 feet to an iron pin on the northwesterly side of Pettigru Street; thence with the northwesterly side of Pettigru Street S 64-00 W 217 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
