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right to use a strip of land ten (10') feet in width across the said premises only during the installation of said pipe line.

This right of way and easement is in addition to a right of way and easement for a four (4") inch water line given by the grantor to Blackinton Mills, Inc., by deed dated June 10, 1953, and recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 480, at page 37.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that the six (6") inch water line shall be constructed along side the four (4") inch water line and within the same ten (10') foot right of way given in the deed referred to above.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that the owner, Henry P. Willimon, is to have the same privileges and right to cultivate and use the right of way strip as he had prior to this agreement, provided that such use thereof will not interfere with the proper operation and maintenance of the said water line.

The payment hereinabove specified covers compensation for the easement or right of way herein granted and also covers all claims for damages along said right of way resulting from the construction of the pipe line to be laid.
