

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Laurens Road which pin is 64.7 feet from the Southeast intersection of Haviland Street and Laurens Road and on the joint corner of lot conveyed by J. A. Moody to G. D. Robertson by deed recorded in Deed Book 287 at page 443 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., and running thence S. 22-15 W. 87 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of this lot with the Robertson lot in the rear; thence N. 70-30 W. 24.2 feet to an iron pin joint corner of this lot and the Vaughn lot; thence N. 21 E. 87.3 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Laurens Road; thence with Laurens Road, S. 72-45 E. 26.2 feet to the point of beginning.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to Ber-Glo, Inc. and Jaypol Corporation by deed of Annie A. Fowler dated March 15, 1952 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Deed Book Vol. 453 at page 26.

On May 27, 1954, Insulators, Inc. merged with Jaypol Corporation, with Insulators, Inc. being the surviving corporation, all of which appears of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 540 at page 447.
