HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Hylan Hewell Adams and John Witherspoon Hewell, III

ALL those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land with the buildings
and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in _____
Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being known and
designated as Tract No. 4 and Tract No. 6 on a plat of property of J. D.
Harris Estate made by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, January, 1953, revised
