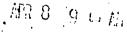

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Greenville Land Co., Inc.
a corporation chartered under the laws of the State ofSouth Carolina
and having its principal place of business at Greenvillein the State ofSouth Carolinafor and in consideration
of the sum of One Thousand, Seven Hundred Seven and 35/100 - (\$1,707.35) Dollars,
to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Larry Shaw, his
heirs and assigns forever:
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 59 of a subdivision known as Orchard Acres, Section Two, as shown on a plat of a portion of said subdivision prepared by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, March, 1960, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at page 6, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern edge of Fairhaven Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 59 and 60, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 81-49 E. 187.7 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot No. 144; thence along the line of that lot, S. 1-13 E. 100 feet to a concrete monument on the northern edge of Northway Drive; thence along the northern edge of Northway Drive, S. 81-33 W. 155 feet to an iron pin; thence following the curvature of Northway Drive as it intersects with Fairhaven Drive, the chord of which is N. 53-27 W. 28.3 feet to an iron pin on the eastern edge of Fairhaven Drive; thence along the eastern edge of Fairhaven Drive, N. 8-27 W. 66.9 feet to a concrete monument; thence continuing along the eastern edge of Fairhaven Drive, N. 7-42 W. 13.1 feet to the beginning corner; being a portion of the property conveyed to the granting corporation by Edward G. Ballard, et al. by deed dated November 9, 1959, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 638, at page 533.
This conveyance is subject to restrictions and protective covenants recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 648, page 169, and is also subject to such drainage and utility easements as appear of record.
