## AMENDMENT OR LEASE AGREEMENT

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

THIS AMENDMENT OF LEASE AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between PERRY E. GWINN, MINNIE G. EARLE, and AILENE S. BURNS of Greenville County, South Carolina, hereinafter referred to as Lessors, and GULF OIL CORPORATION, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as Lessee:

## <u>WITHESSETH</u>

THAT WHEREAS, by Lease Agreement, dated March 17, 1956, and recorded March 30, 1956, in the Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 549, Page 117, MRS. FANNIE G.
