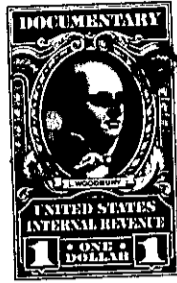

Know all Men by these Presents, That We, Henry Burnett, Milford Burnett,  
Carrie B. Myers, and Mary Lou B. Curry,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand, Four Hundred Fifty-five -  
----- (\$10,455.00) ----- Dollars

to the said Grantors in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
Greenville-Spartanburg Airport District (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville-Spartanburg Airport District,  
its successors and assigns forever, the following described property:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick  
Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, about two  
miles North of Pelham, South Carolina, on both sides of the Greer-Pelham  
Road being bounded on the West by lands now or formerly belonging to James  
B. Myers and Carrie B. Myers, and to W. Henry Burnett and to P. L. Mayfield,  
on the North by lands now or formerly belonging to Clarence Smith, on the  
East by lands now or formerly belonging to D. S. Burnett, and on the South  
by the cross road which now leads from the Old Pelham Road to the Greer-Pelham  
Road and by lands now or formerly belonging to Jimmie Nell Smith Blackman, to  
Nannie J. D. Smith, and Jack Hubert Smith as shown on a plat prepared by  
H. S. Brockman, dated January 28, 1958, entitled "Property of J. G. Burnett  
Estate", and being known and designated as Tract No. 173 as shown on a plat  
entitled "Property Ownership Map Prepared for Greenville-Spartanburg Airport  
Commission", dated June 23, 1960, prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service,  
and having such metes and bounds as shown on a plat entitled "Property of  
Henry Burnett, et al.", dated March 15, 1960, and compiled by Piedmont Engi-  
neering Service, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northwestern corner of the premises herein  
described and the line of property now or formerly belonging to Clarence Smith  
and running thence with the line of said Smith property S. 87-10 E. 1451 feet  
to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly belonging to  
D. S. Burnett S. 3-07 W. 733 feet to a point in or near the cross road referred  
to hereinabove and at the joint corner of property now or formerly belonging  
to Jimmie Nell Smith Blackman; thence with said road and with the line of said  
Blackman property and property now or formerly belonging to Nannie J. D. Smith  
and to Jack Hubert Smith N. 82-00 W. 854.1 feet to a point in the Greer-Pelham  
Road; thence with the said Greer-Pelham Road and with the line of property now  
or formerly belonging to James B. Myers and Carrie B. Myers and to W. Henry  
Burnett N. 2-20 W. 400 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the line of  
said Burnett property N. 81-00 W. 518 feet to an iron pin in the line of pro-  
perty now or formerly belonging to P. L. Mayfield; thence with the line of said  
Mayfield property N. 10-40 W. 209 feet to the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property devised to Henry Burnett, Milford Burnett,  
Carrie B. Myers and Mary Lou B. Curry under the provisions of Item III of the
