All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the north side of Mulberry Street, in the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having, according to a plat and survey of property of S. L. and Lula P. Simmons, prepared by G. A. Ellis, Surveyor, November 20, 1948, recorded in Plat Book V, page 2, RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Mulberry Street at the southwesterly corner of property now or formerly of L. L. Echols, and running thence along the line of Echols lot N. 31-30 W. 105 feet, more or less, to iron pin; thence S. 58-30 W. 135 feet to iron pin (NM); thence along line of other property of Grantor S. 31-30 E. 105 feet to iron pin (NM) on north side of Mulberry Street; thence along north side of Mulberry Street N. 58-30 E. 135 feet to point of beginning. See Deeds Volume 366, page 85.

ALSO

All that certain lot; piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in the second Ward of the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the east side of Brown Street; and running thence in a southerly direction along said Brown Street 150 feet to the northeast corner of Brown and East Coffee Street; thence in an easterly direction along the north side of East Coffee Street 100 feet to a stake; thence in a northerly direction along line of lot belonging to the Estate of James Finlay, deceased, 150 feet to a stake; thence in a westerly direction along line of lot belonging to Mrs. Lillie L. Reilly 100 feet to the beginning corner. See Deeds Volume 613, page 346.
