Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, LILLI H. JOSEPH in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100----- (\$1.00) DOLLARS.

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said GEORGE J. JOSEPH, JR., his heirs and assigns, forever: ALL of my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-half interest, in and to the following described property:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the East side of Old Augusta Road, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as a part of Lot 3 on plat of McDaniel Tract, property of Howard Caldwell, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "E", at Page 218, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Old Augusta Road at joint corner of Lots 2 and 3 and running thence with the line of Lot 2, N 60-45 E, 241.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S 1-17 W, 55.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S 62-45 W, 240.5 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Old Augusta Road; thence along the East side of Old Augusta Road, N 1-45 W, 57.1 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantor and the grantee by deed of Victor A. Tatum and Rebecca M. Tatum, dated July 15, 1957, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 580, at page 283.

The Grantee assumes and agrees to pay the balance due on that mortgage given by Victor A. Tatum and Rebecca M. Tatum to The Prudential Insurance Company of America, dated February 6, 1956, in the original amount of \$10,350.00, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Mortgage Book 667, at Page 377. Grantee to pay 1961 taxes.

This deed is to correct deed dated May 17, 1961 between the same parties in which the Grantee was shown as George J. Joseph, whereas it was the intention of the parties that the Grantee should be George J. Joseph, Jr. The deed to be corrected is recorded in Deed Book 674 at Page 94 of the R.M.C. Office. TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging,

or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
