R. Gault, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying, being and situate in the County and State aforesaid, Fairview Township and in the Town of Fountain Inn, on the North or Northwestern side of Woodvale Avenue, being known and designated as Lot No. 9 of the L. R. Gault property, with the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Woodvale Avenue, joint front corner with Lot No. 8, and running thence with said Woodvale Avenue N. 37 E. 80 feet to an iron pin in the edge of a 30 foot street that leads off Woodvale Avenue into property of the said L.
