CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

GEORGE ROSS, WADE H. STEPHENS, JR., and GEORGE ROSS, JR.,

all of

227 Pendleton Street, Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 8th day of March, 1961, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is ROSS-SOCAR REALTY CORPORATION

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 227 Pendleton Street, Greenville, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to acquire, own, improve, develop, lease, exchange and sell real estate, improvements to real estate, equipment and fixtures; to buy, sell, lease and deal in machinery, equipment and other merchandise.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars payable in money or money's worth on call of the Board of Directors

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Five Hundred (500) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) each Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 6th day of March, 1961, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

George Ross, Wade H. Stephens, Jr., and George Ross, Jr.

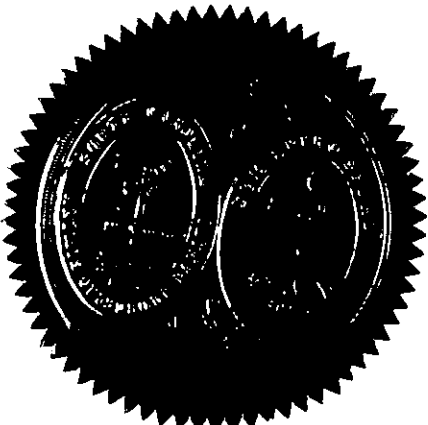
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, George Ross; as Vice-President, Wade H. Stephens, Jr.; as Secretary, George Ross, Jr.; as Treasurer, George Ross, Jr.

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
