

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing two hundred forty-four and one-half (244) acres, more or less, being known as the Scott Place, located on the Horse Creek Road, ten (10) miles from Honea Path, S.C., on the head waters of Horse Creek, bounded on the north by lands of J. R. Knight; on the east by lands of Melvin Thomason and Cothran; on the south by lands of J. A. McCullough; on the west by lands of Horton, and having the following courses and distances according to survey and plat of W. M. Nash, surveyor, October 24, 1912:

Xom; thence N. 31-00 W. 4.65° chains to stone; thence S. 82-45 W. 58.50° chains to stone; thence S. 4-15 W. 10.73° chains to stone; thence S. 81-30 E. 15.95° chains to stone om in branch, beginning corner.
