CHARTER  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

WM. BYRD TRAXLER and CALHOUN H. TURNER

both of

Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 6th day of September, 1961, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **ALLIED TEXTILE SALES, INC.**

THIRD: That the principal place of business is P. O. Box 6355, Branwood Station, 315 Pendleton Road, Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

That the general nature of the business which it proposes to do is to receive, buy, acquire, sell, dispose of, process, grade, classify, sort, bale, appraise, and generally to handle and deal in textile by-products, including but not limited to textile remnants, mill ends and piece goods; to purchase, acquire, hold, lease, sell and otherwise dispose of such real and personal property as may be necessary or incidental to the stated business of the Corporation; to borrow money, give and receive notes, mortgages, assignments or other security instruments necessary and related to the operation of this Corporation; to pledge the credit of the Corporation and to execute and deliver, as well as to receive any and all other documents, including but not limited to contracts, agreements, bills of sale, bills of lading, and to make assignments thereof, such as may be necessary or incidental to the operation of the Corporation, and to do any and all other acts to the same extent as they are permitted by law to all business corporations of this state and to exercise all such express or implied powers as may be necessary and incidental to the declared business of this Corporation.*
