All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on the Northwest side of East Perry Road Ext., and being shown as all of lot number NINETEEN (19) on a plat of property made for the within grantors and entitled "Leawood Hills", made by Terry T. Dill, surveyor, dated Oct. 1958, and has the following metes and bounds according to said plat, to wit:
