## DISSOLUTION OF PARTNERSHIP

· WHEREAS, J.P. Strother and J.P. Edwards have heretofore done business as a partnership under the firm name of Strother & Edwards Agency, formerly known as The Friendly Finance Company, the terms of which partnership are set forth in articles of agreement entered into between the parties on January 11, 1954, amended January 25, 1961; and,

WHEREAS, by agreement between the parties, J.P. Stother has been sole operator of the real estate and rental business and J.P. Edwards has been sole operator of the accounting business, but they have continued to operate an insurance agency until this date; and,

EHEREAS, the parties have now mutually agreed to discontinue the remaining phase of the partnership, that is to say, the insurance agency, it being mutually agreed between the parties as follows:

In consideration of the sum of Thirty-six Hundred (\$3600.00) Pollars in hand paid by J.P. Strother to J.P. Edwards, receipt whereof is duly acknowledged, the entire busurance agency, together with all of its accounts and liquid assets, shall become the sole property of J.P. Strother, it being mutually agreed that the said J.P. Strother shall also assume all outstanding accounts payable in connection with the operation of the insurance business. In other words, J.P. Strother is assuming all liability in connection with the casualty insurance as written and on books of the firm at this date or to be hereafter incurred, and is to receive and to hold all of the assets pertaining to the casualty insurance accounts, including any cash on hand, and in bank.

It is agreed between the parties that J.P. Edwards shall receive as his share of the office furniture, equipment and supplies, one Victor adding machine; one Remington typewriter; one secretarial desk, chair and lamp; one bookcase and contents; one steel storage cabinet; one legal
