

## The State of South Carolina,

CHARTER  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, FILED  
GREENVILLE CO. S. C. PATRICK C. FANT and FRANCES B. HOLTZCLAW

both of

Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 16th day of November, 1961, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is WILCO AVIATION, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is P. O. Box 840, c/o J. P. Williamson,  
Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to buy, sell, own, operate, lease, rent, charter, and deal in air planes, equipment and supplies, and property of every kind and nature, and to do and perform any and all acts and things authorized to be done by corporations under the general laws of South Carolina, or that may be necessary and incidental to said business and for carrying out of the purpose of the corporation.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twenty-Five Thousand (\$25,000.00)----- Dollars payable in cash at the call of the directors.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Two Hundred Fifty (250) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00)-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 7th day of November, 1961, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: J. P. Williamson and J. P. Williamson, Jr.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, J. P. Williamson ;  
as Vice-President, J. P. Williamson, Jr. ; as Secretary, Vida K. Badger ;  
as Treasurer, J. P. Williamson

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.

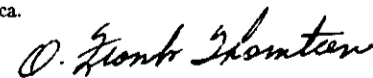
