Warren Winfield Gibson, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever, an undivided two-thirds interest in and to all that tract of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, on the south side of Hooper's Creek, containing 46 acres more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to the Grantor herein by G. C. Gibson by deed dated January 3, 1925 and of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 98 at Page 325.

Also, an undivided two-thirds interest in and to all that certain parcel or tract of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as a part of the land conveyed to John Shockley by the heirs of Sarah Shockley by deed dated June 23, 1890, containing 12 acres, more or less, and being the same tract conveyed to the Grantor herein by Robert Williams and Pawline Williams by deed dated January 24, 1938 and of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 201 at Page 447.

Reserving, however, unto the Grantor a life estate in and to the premises above described.
