CONVEYANCE OF BENEFICIAL

INTEREST IN TRUST ESTATE

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, John McFall Breazeale, in consideration of the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00), do hereby grant, bargain, sell, release, assign and transfer unto Gerda Luyties Prevost my beneficial interest in and to the corpus of the said trust estate, the interest hereby conveyed being a one-twentieth (1/20th) interest, together with my interest in and to any and all rents, issues, income and all other payments that may hereafter become due to me under or by virtue of the said trust estate aforementioned.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto Gerda Luyties Prevost, her heirs and assigns forever.
