Johnson, their heirs and assigns, forever,

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being therein in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in the City of Greenville, described as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on Railroad Street and running thence South 5-11 West 30.4 feet to a stake; thence North 77-30 West 125.4 feet to a stake; thence North 15 West 30 feet to a stake; thence South 77-30 East 120.6 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same lot of land conveyed to Fletcher Broom by deed of Henry Campbell, dated August 27, 1921, and recorded in Deed Book 74 at page 33.

The total purchase price of this property is the sum of \$3500.00. The grantor acquired a one-eighth interest in this property as an heir at law of Louise Whitaker.
