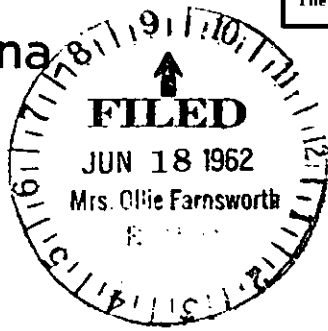

All that certain parcel or tract of land situate in O'Neal Township, County and State aforesaid, containing four (4) acres, more or less, being bounded on the South and West by property of Ethel Brown, Alta B. Cox, Liza Brown, Henry Brown and R. C. Brown, being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Northwest corner of the St. Luke Church property to the East and Pine Log Ford Road to the North, this being the point of beginning: thence west 400 feet along south side of Pine Log Ford Road to a point; thence South along a new line 400 feet to a point; thence East along another new line 400 feet to a point; thence north 400 feet along west line of the St. Luke Church property to the point of beginning.

This being a portion of an 8 acre tract of land, more or less, being listed in judgement roll E. 10654 in the County Courthouse of Greenville, S. C. and assigned to Ethel Brown, Henry Brown, Alta B.
