CHARTER  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

J. M. Perry and B. J. McGee

of

409 East North Street, Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 5th day of July, 1962, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is A. S. B. OF FLORENCE, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

That the general nature of the business which it proposes to do is* To carry on as owner or lessee with all the necessary adjuncts and appointments, restaurants and snack bars for the serving and sale of all kinds of food, cigars, tobacco, drinkables, news stands, and all other privileges and facilities designed to contribute to the benefit and convenience of guests and customers; to engage in the business of operating and servicing vending machines, or any other act, whether manufacturing or otherwise, which may seem advantageous or useful in connection therewith, and to manufacture, market or prepare for market any articles or thing which the company uses in connection with its business; and in connection with the foregoing to manufacture, market and prepare for market, buy, sell and deal in anything which may be useful in connection with the manufacturing or marketing, vending or shipping of the products of the company, or like products.
