

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That L. EDVARD USRY

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand One Hundred Fifty Six and assumption of mortgage referred to below Dollars to ... me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by RICHARD R. BLOWER and KATHRYN LEE BLOWER (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Richard R. Blower and Kathryn Lee Blower, their heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the East side of Hermitage Road, near the City of Greenville in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as lot no. 121 on a revision of a portion of plat of Sections II and III of Lake Forest Subdivision made by Piedmont Engineering Service, July 1955, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book "BB" at page 20 and having according to said plat the following metes

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Hermitage Road, at joint front corner of lots 120 and 121, and running thence along the line of lot 120 S 36-31 E, 178.1 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of lots 120 and 121, said point being at the edge of the highwater mark of Lake Fairfield; thence along the highwater mark of Lake Fairfield to a point in branch (the traverse line being S 14-33 E, 75.3 feet;) thence along the center of the branch to a point on the East side of Hermitage Road (the traverse line being S 63-43 W, 232.2 feet) thence along the East side of Hermitage Road, N 3-29 E, 136.9 feet to the
