To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:
WHEREAS, Jack Edgar Tumblin & Frances M. Tumblin, minors over the
age of fourteen years, by their Guardian ad Litem, Harold N. Morris
on or about the 12th day of June in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and Sixty Two exhibited their
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against
John D. Huff

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard
on the 7th day of July 1962,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and
decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for
the County aforesaid, to John D. Huff

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of
Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto
the said John D. Huff

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Green-
ville County, State of South Carolina, fronting on South Carolina
Highway No. 25, containing one and ten one-hundredths (1.10) acres,
more or less, and having, according to plat made by J. Coke Smith in
1946 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the northern side of Highway No. 25, at
corner of property now or formerly owned by F. Dillanshaw, and running
thence N. 44 E. one hundred and fifty-six (156) feet to a rock on line
of said Dillanshaw; thence S. 42-25 E. two hundred and ninety-seven
(297) feet along the line of property now or formerly owned by L. J.
Huff; thence still along the line of property of L. J. Huff S. 62-15 W.
two hundred and thirty-three (233) feet to a point on northern side of
said Highway No. 25; thence along the northern boundary of said Highway
No. 25 N. 84-40 W. two hundred thirty-eight and eight-tenths (238.8)
feet to the beginning corner.
